Dear People of St. Paul's Elkins Park,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Christ. My name is Max Accime, an old friend of Fr. Simpson Coriolan. I'm 56 years old and I'm the priest-in-charge of Saint Thomas parish, Arcahaie, Haiti. I have been ordained for 29 years and have been married since December 1994 and have four kids.

St. Thomas has been struggling since the earthquakes. The right aisle of the church is leaning and 3 of the school's classrooms have been damaged. That situation has made it impossible for us to open our doors for the new school year. The school has 460 students.

Without the support of our sisters and brothers, I fear we will not make it. The community has about 237 families who are struggling. Their houses have been destroyed and help from aid organizations has not been able to reach them. We hope that you will keep us in your thoughts and prayers.

I look forward to hearing from you.
